

# Grades 3-8 INDIVIDUAL STUDENT PROGRESS


Year-to-year progress in English language arts and mathematics.

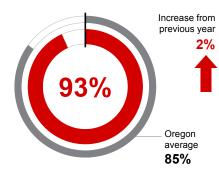
## Grade 8 MATHEMATICS

Students meeting state grade-level expectations.




# Grade 9 **ON-TRACK TO GRADUATE**
