

**REGISTRATION OF BOARD CANDIDACY
MONROE SCHOOL DISTRICT #1J**

March 21, 2019 at 5:00 PM is the deadline for interested persons to file their declaration of candidacy or petition of nomination for the Monroe School District #1J Board of Directors for the school board election to be held on May 21, 2019. **First day to file is February 9, 2019.** All declarations or petitions must be filed with Benton County Department of Elections.

Zones up for election this year are:

Zone 1, 2 year term. Currently held by Tyler Sherman. Zone 1 boundary lines are: Intersection of Alpine Cut-off Road and Hwy 99 West; west on Alpine Cut-off Road to Orchard Tract; south on Orchard Tract to Coon Road (includes east side of Orchard Tract); east on Coon/Orchard Street to Hwy 99 West; north to Alpine Cut-off Road.

Zone 2, 4 year term. Currently held by Tim Warden. Zone 2 boundary lines are: Intersection of Kyle and Alpine Roads, West on Alpine Road to Bellfountain Road, North on Bellfountain Road to Dykstra Road, West on Dykstra Road to Foster Road, West on Foster Road to McCain Road, West to Green Peak Road, Green Peak Road to B.L.M. South Fork Road, West to West District Boundary Line, South to South District Boundary Line, East to Cherry Creek (the creek, not the road), Cherry Creek to Coon Road, East to Kyle Road, North to Intersection of Kyle and Alpine Roads.

Zone 3, 4 year term. Currently held by Riley Holman. Zone 3 boundary lines are: Intersection of Hwy 99 West and North District Boundary Line, West to West District Boundary Line South to B.L.M. South Fork Road, East to McCain Road, East on Foster Road to Dykstra Road, East on Dykstra Road to Bellfountain Road, South on Bellfountain Road to Alpine Road, West on Alpine Road to Alpine Cut-off Road, West on Alpine Cut-off Road to Hwy 99 West, North on Hwy 99 West to North District Boundary Line.

Persons will be eligible to serve as members of the Board if they are qualified voters of the District and have been residents within the district for one year immediately preceding the election, and currently reside within the zone they wish to represent. No person who is an employee of the District will be eligible to serve as a member of the Board while so employed.
