Traffic Safety Education

If a driver education program is provided by the district, The following procedures shall be used in implementing the district's traffic safety education program.

Tuition Rate

Each year prior to the Board's organizational meeting, following July 1, the Superintendent will propose a tuition rate for Board adoption.

Home School Students, Private School and Charter School Students

The Superintendent may send a letter inviting resident Home School, Private School and Charter School students to participate in this program. These students will be accepted after District enrolled students and before out of District students if they meet student requirements for this class. These students must enroll as a Monroe High School student for this class and pay the same tuition as a resident student.

The Superintendent may send a letter inviting nonresident student application. Such application shall establish a "waiting list." The waiting list shall be based upon a "first come, first served" basis. These students must enroll in Monroe High School as a student for this class and pay the same tuition as a resident student.

All students shall be subject to the district's code of conduct, policies and administrative regulations. Violation may result in disciplinary action up to and including removal from the traffic safety education program.

Reduction or Waived Tuition

The Superintendent shall have the right to waive all or part of the tuition. Fees for homeless students will be waived.
