

Monroe High School Graduation Ceremonies

1. Graduates must be enrolled at Monroe High School at the time of graduation.
2. Seniors must maintain regular attendance for the entire school year. (No more than 8 unexcused ½ day absences in any four week period, as per ORS 339.065, and/or no more than ten (10) consecutive full day absences.
3. Seniors are expected to maintain appropriate behavior while attending school and at all school related events. Those who do not may forfeit commencement privileges.
4. Any senior enrolled in and attending alternative programs which grant diplomas or certificates (such as Linn-Benton Community College High School Diploma program) will go through the ceremony with that program and not at Monroe High School.
5. Senior transcripts will be reviewed for graduation at the completion of the seventh semester of course work. Students who are not on track to graduate at the completion of the eighth semester will be required to meet with the counselor and principal to create a plan for graduation, if possible. Students with the required number of credits or an approved graduation plan will be allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony upon successful completion of the required credits/completion of their approved plan. **Any student that has not completed the credits required to graduate at the completion of the eighth semester will not be permitted to participate in the graduation ceremony.**
