

School Attendance Areas

It is the goal of the school Board to provide an educational program for all youth living within district legal boundaries, who are otherwise entitled to free, public education. The Board will determine attendance boundaries for the schools of the district and will assign children to these schools as necessary. The Board may admit children residing in other school districts, and may require tuition payments as determined on an individual basis.

The superintendent has the power and duty to recommend to the Board the establishment or alteration of attendance boundaries for all schools in the interest of good administration of the instructional program.
