

Public Solicitation in District Facilities

Fund raising by nonschool agencies or for nonschool activities during school hours will not be permitted without prior approval of the superintendent and/or principal.

Demonstrations of services or materials and canvassing of students or any school employee for the purpose of selling products or services shall not be permitted in either the district's schools or school grounds, unless authorized by the superintendent and/or principal.

No nondistrict-sponsored organization or individual may solicit funds or sell tickets within the district without first securing permission through the superintendent and/or principal.

Whenever possible, solicitation should occur during non-classroom time.
