

### **Policy Implementation**

The superintendent is responsible for implementing Board policies and for interpreting them to staff, students and the public. Other administrators share in this responsibility.

Any administrative regulation specifically mentioned and/or required in the pages of the District's Policy Manual shall be reviewed and approved by the Board. The Board shall review any other administrative regulation and may revise it by a majority vote if in the Board's judgement, such regulation is not consistent or representative with adopted policies and/or practices of the Board.

Policies officially adopted by the Board and other administrative regulations formulated to implement adopted Board policies will be included in the School Board Policy Handbook (and Regulations). Staff, student and parent handbooks also will be used for disseminating policies and regulations to persons directly affected by them.

Principals are authorized to establish rules and procedures for the staff and student bodies of their schools as long as these rules and procedures are consistent with policies and regulations established by the Board and superintendent.
