

Disposal of School Property

School equipment, property not needed for educational purposes, or unclaimed property may be disposed of by the superintendent with the approval of the Board.

Generally those items of any significant monetary value will be advertised for sale to the public by a bidding procedure. Items of an insignificant monetary value may be disposed of, or discarded, at the discretion of the Superintendent.

Items of sentimental value (trophies, awards, art work, etc.) shall be displayed, stored or disposed of in accordance with District regulations.

In the case of surplus real estate or any titled vehicle, disposition shall be in accordance with state law.

If the district property was purchased with state, federal or private grant funds disposal of the property shall be made as outlined in the grant or by state or federal regulations.
