

Facilities Renovation And/or Repair

The Board's priorities for funding renovation of facilities are as follows:

First priority - protection of life, health and safety; compliance with mandated requirements governing construction codes and fire safety requirements;

Second priority - all others.

The participation of staff, parents and the community in the development of plans for new and renovated facilities will be actively solicited.

The superintendent will establish procedures for requesting, approving and scheduling facilities renovation and/or repair.

Plans for new and remodeled buildings will be designed and offer accommodations to make them accessible to persons with disabilities. The Board will review construction plans to assure that new and remodeled buildings are made fully accessible.
