









By June 1, 2018, 60% of all students in grades K-6 will be reading at benchmark according to DIBELS Spring benchmark data. By June 1, 2020, 65% of all students in grade K-8 will be at benchmark according DIBELS Math/easy CBM Spring Benchmark

By June 1, 2019, 72% of all students in grades 7-8 will be reading at benchmark according to DIBELS (CARI) Spring benchmark







