(500 words or less)	Given severely limited student contact, we chose to focus our SIA efforts on campus security in preparation for students returning in the fall of 2021, as well as student engagement in extra-curricular activities and family communication through the use of the Blackboard system. In the fall of 2021, we will be focusing our efforts on student connection and care.
2	What barriers, impediments, or challenges to your SIA implementation have you faced or identified that are helpful for your community and/or state leaders to be aware of? (500 words or less)	Other than a year of distance learning and trying to support staff and student technical needs, teaching and learning needs, and mental health needs, the only barrier we've run into (in a limited sense) is the general shortage of certified staff. We felt very fortunate to find the Success Coaches/Counselors back in the spring and only hired the Life Skills teacher in October. We feel very lucky to have them at all given the situation currently.
3	SIA implementation includes ongoing engagement with focal students, the families of focal students, and educators. What successes and challenges, if any, have you experienced in maintaining engagement? (500 words or less)	During COVID, we found the Blackboard communication tool to be very helpful in connected us with our students and families. It serves as an efficient and effective tool for getting information out as well as having the ability to function as a survey tool. As a small district, we are in constant communication with our students, families and stakeholders.
