Sights to See in Oregon

Tamolitch Falls, better known as "Blue Pool", is a beautiful, cliff-rimmed, water hole. It's nicknamed blue pool because of its 30 foot deep, 37 degree, turquoise-blue colored water. The main trails to access the pool are the Carmen Smith Reservoir and McKenzie River Trailhead. This sight is located in McKenzie Bridge, OR, about an hour and a half from Monroe. Many people enjoy the 4 mile hike, though some parts of the trail are a little rocky and potentially dangerous. Make sure to bring close toed, hiking shoes! When arriving at the stunning water, some people cliff jump and swim, while others enjoy the view from above. It is important to remember the dangers of the freezing cold water combined with the jumping impact, some people have had fatal accidents at blue pool and many have required rescues. Apart from these incidents, the blue pool is a safe place to swim for short periods of time but cliff jumping is no longer encouraged.

The main reason why the water is so clear and clean is because no fish or microorganisms can survive in these water temperatures. The lava rock in the blue pool also filters the river water as it flows through, keeping the water free of debris.

Blue pool is open all year long, but it might be best to plan your trip in the spring or summer if you're planning on swimming. On the other hand, fall is said to be the best season for the hike. Regardless of the time of year, it is a gorgeous sight to see in Oregon and I would highly recommend planning a trip!

Forager is a survival-adventure game released on April 18th, 2019. In-game you start on a small island and slowly but surely buy more land and expand your appliances.

The game has a plethora of achievements and quests to complete, and has a lackluster or absence of story, at all.

Due to the game's layout this is no issue though.

The main gameplay of Forager is that you start on a small island with randomly spawning plants and ores that will appear on your island, harvesting these materials earns you the capability to create tools, appliances, and money. Capitalism is present in this game, there are many plots of land you can buy to expand your island, all land plots have their own special quirks like an NPC or a puzzle to solve: later on you are able to build markets as well, which sell a variety of good deeds.

One of the game's major mechanics is leveling up your skill tree, the skill tree itself is the anchor for you to unlock all different types of things in Forager, there are four main branches in Forager that you can invest in: Capitalism, Sorcery, Industrial, and farming. You are able to invest in all four however you please, their bonuses vary but often can be found unlocking a new appliance or giving you buffs. Unlocking recipes in Forager is integral to making progress, which there is no proper ending to the game. There's lots of side quests and end-game content for one to explore once they've gotten their hold on a good balanced skill tree, you'll be able to find many strange relics and eventually even be able to access a whole new dimension. Once you've gotten far enough in the game.

Foragers overall gameplay is quite enjoyable, many can compare it to it's fellow survival-adventure titles like Minecraft or Terraria. It often feels as though you can always increase your productivity in the game, as there is no limit to how much you can build, destroy, and create.

Its runtime feels endless and may possibly even *be* endless if you don't play the game non-stop.

Compiling the fine details of Forager can be an difficult venture as there's so much unique content and passion put into this small indie-game, it's only flaws really being how much it doesn't tell you, so there are times where you will have to research something like the solve for a puzzle yourself.

The game earns a 7/10. It's enjoyable, but no masterpiece. Try it if you'd like.

Strawberries are a commonly consumed fruit, they are red and delicious. Strawberries have small seeds not tasted but felt on the outside of the fruit. A strawberry is a widely grown hybrid species of the genus fragaria. The fruit is greatly appreciated for its characteristic aroma, bright color, juicy texture and sweetness. It is consumed in large quantities, either fresh or in prepared fruits like jam, juice, pies, icecream, and milkshakes. The artificial flavoring or smell of strawberries is also a very big seller. People buy it in things like soaps, lip glosses and perfumes. Strawberries were first bred in France in the 1700's.

Raspberries are a fruit that is very popular, raspberries are perennials meaning that the plant flowers and produces fruit more than once. They need ample sun and water for optimal development. Raspberries thrive in well drained soil with a ph between 6 and 7, they want lots of organic matter to assist in retaining water. As a plant cultivated in warm, moist temperate regions it is easily grown and has a tendency to spread unless pruned. Escaped raspberries often appear as garden weeds and can at first be thought to be black berries.

Amur Leopard By Mikayla Smith

With only about 30 individuals left in the wild the Amur leopard is both an endangered and rare to see animal. What makes the Amur leopard different from others is their lighter color coat with very dark, distinct, and unbroken rings that are more spaced out and larger than many others. They are one of the eight different subspecies of leopard and are found only in far east Russia and north eastern China. These animals need a cold climate and have thick fur adapted to blend better in the snow. The males normally weigh around 71-110 pounds while females weigh around 55-94 but these leopards can still manage to take down prey up to three times their size. Although there are a little less than 200 captive Amur Leopards, this species is still one of the

world's most endangered big cats and is classified as critically endangered on the IUCN red list.
