Reviewed and discussed Board Goals 2023-24:

A. Build five-year district-wide maintenance plan (keep as a Board goal)

Work in progress. Facility improvements continue to be completed. Currently working on lighting and flooring projects, as well as the next round of seismic grants. Have formed a facilities committee and checklist document for review. Will schedule a district walk through in September.

B. Continue to build and expand CTE programming (keep as a Board goal)

Discussion on challenges to creating new CTE programming (licensure, student interest, facility) and programs that have started or are being considered (manufacturing, culinary arts, medical professions, computer science / coding, broadcast journalism). The Board expressed interest in continuing to build and expand our post-school / career planning processes (Senior Project, additional trade / job connections, career exploration course).

C. Continue to emphasize communication at all levels (keep as a Board goal)

Communication has improved. Will continue to work on consistency and developing district-wide systems and to eliminate redundant / specialized communication platforms. Will appoint a board member to participate in the investigation and potential selection of communication system vendors.
